

INTERVIEW CRITERIA OF SENIOR RESIDENT IN ORTHODONTICS

As per the request received from the HOD of Orthodontics department, it has been decided to appoint two senior residents in department of Orthodontics on contract basis through Hospital Development Committee (As per reference – minutes of HDC dated 19-01-2026).

➤ The appointment is only for a period of 11 months with monthly payment of Rupees 65,000/-(Sixty Five thousand only) for one Senior Resident. An Interview can be conducted at Principal Chamber/Conference room by including following members.

- (1) Principal & Vice Chairman of HDC
- (2) HOD – Orthodontics
- (3) Faculty from Orthodontics (Senior Faculty)
- (4) Secretary, HDC
- (5) Accounts Officer

➤ A preliminary written / MCQ exam can be conducted at the department level, if needed before the interview.

➤ Existing Senior Resident, who is working on contract basis can be considered only if new candidates are not available.

➤ Eligibility

- (1) Candidates who are having MDS degree in Orthodontics from any DCI recognised institutions.
- (2) Candidates who are having current Kerala Dental Council registration in MDS – Orthodontics.

OVERVIEW

Residency program is an 11 months program starting from **AUGUST 2026** and ending by **JULY 2027**.

Duties and responsibilities

- Develops appropriate treatment plans and provides preventive and corrective services. Reviews and evaluates treatment procedures and outcomes [OP duty from 11 am to 2pm]
- Provide clinical supervision to the Junior residents/ House surgeons and undergraduates
- In- Charge of Dental Operating Room Assistant (DORA)
- Formulating appropriate diagnosis and treatment planning for complex cases requiring fixed appliances.
- Maintains dental records of patients and accurately documents review of medical history and physical status of patients.
- Attends and participates in staff meetings; attends interdisciplinary conferences involving dental treatments and care.
- Present Case reports and seminars related to the different topics of Orthodontics of their interest.
- The candidate should undertake one research projects in Orthodontics and publish the findings.

SELECTION PROCESS

- A notification for recruitment will be issues through local media and newspapers regarding the hiring of Senior Resident to the Department
- In case the number of candidates exceed 5, an MCQ based screening exam comprising of 30 questions from all the major topics in Orthodontics [*from two reference textbooks 1. Contemporary Orthodontics 7th edition Willam R Proffitt, Handbook of Orthodontics 3rd edition Martyn T. Cobourne and Andrew T. DiBiase*], will be conducted to test their knowledge and aptitude, based on which **5 candidates** will be shortlisted for Interview which will be conducted on **16-07-2026**
- Candidate will be selected via direct interview by a panel comprising of the Principal , Head of the Department and esteemed members of the Hospital Development Society
